Cancellation of Florence Municipal Court In-Person Court Proceedings

FLORENCE, SC – Under the direction of the South Carolina Supreme Court, all in-person court proceedings have been postponed; therefore, traffic and criminal court sessions scheduled in Florence Municipal Court are suspended until further notice.

Beginning with court scheduled at 9:00am on Monday, January 11, 2021, the City of Florence Municipal Court WILL NOT hold morning court, afternoon court, or jury trials until further notice. Defendants with scheduled court appearances will be notified by mail of your rescheduled court date.

The goal is to reduce gatherings of large groups and to encourage recommended "social distancing" guidelines to contain and mitigate the COVID-19 virus spread. City officials will continue to monitor the impact and need of such restrictions, and under the direction of the South Carolina Supreme Court will re-evaluate these actions as circumstances change.
